# Educational Adequacy -Teaching Staff Input-

### 18 Categories were reviewed with Session Participants

- For each category staff were to write (on "sticky" notes) comments about their facility space/environment
  - Blue Sticky = Perceived Need or Deficiency
  - Yellow Sticky = Perceived Area of Satisfaction
- Sheets representing each category were placed throughout the room
- Staff placed sticky note(s) with comments on each corresponding category

## Educational Adequacy Color Codes:

Green

<u>Adequate</u> – Meets most of the Analysis Criteria including Minnesota Department of Education (MDE) Guidelines for Educational Adequacy – not a perceived staff need

Yellow

<u>Questionable Adequacy</u> – Meets some of the Analysis Criteria, but may be considered adequate based upon current programming/enrollment and/or size of area

Red

<u>Inadequate</u> – Meets 1 or none of the Analysis Criteria - Is perceived as a significant need by staff

Green

<u>Adequate</u> – Meets most of the Analysis Criteria including Minnesota Department of Education (MDE) Guidelines for Educational Adequacy – not a perceived staff need

## The "Big 5" Staff Needs


- Staff to reflect on the discussions, comments and thoughts from the session

What would you like the Headlines to be of the newspaper 10 years from now about the Brainerd Schools?


